Unapproved Minutes for June 19, 2018 Council Meeting

Members present: D. DeFrang, N. Holen, P. Hook, V. Jones, R. Kephart, P. Olson, D. Peterson and Pastor John.

Members absent: none

Consent Agenda: The Consent Agenda was approved after the following items were discussed. Financial reports-The church is currently in deficient spending partly due to monthly offerings decreasing. There have been some complications with the accounting system, but the glitches are being worked out. The council approved that Velma Jones is the council representative when the church's financial reports are being reviewed. The council will revisit Bethany's financial situation at the July meeting. Pastor's report- Pastor John informed the council that the first available time for Bishop Tom Aitken to visit Bethany is November 11. The Bishop will preach and preside over communion at the 9:30 service that day. Pastor John also gave the council some possible dates for a first communion class.

Old Business: none

New Business: A. Tour Parsonage- The council toured the parsonage and visited with Darcy and Tim about any concerns they might have. The council approved purchasing a backup sump pump to have on hand in case it was ever needed. The parsonage will also be getting a new dishwasher since the old dishwasher hasn't worked for some time. B. Annual Meeting recap- The council encourages members to sign up on the money chart to help replenish the memorial fund. C. Little Free Pantry- This project will be moving forward. The maintenance will be taken care of by the Onamia Early Childhood Coalition. D. Parsonage lawn- The council approved having the lawn sprayed three times this summer. One application had already occurred and there already seems to be an improvement on the amount of Creeping Charlie on the lawn. E. Check Signer- Bethany needed another check signer and the council approved Pam Olson to handle this task.

Project Updates: A. Annual projects list– The Naming Project Campers will be here on August 5 between 5-6. Please talk to Darcy or Sandy K. if you can help or would like to donate monies to help with the cost of food. B. Operation Community Connect recap- Norma was the Bethany representative at this event in early June. She reported a good turnout and that many people went over to Ruby's Pantry after being at Operation Community Connect. C. Blue Tooth Loops- Patti visited a churched that was using a blue tooth system to help the hard of hearing hear during the church service. The council plans to research Blue Tooth.

Next month's council meeting will be Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 7:00 PM. Meeting was adjourned, Dixie Peterson, council secretary


