In April and May congregation members were invited to group conversations which lead to the development of this Mission Music Schedule 5 Plan. Three formal conversation were held in five sessions engaging 27 members of Bethany. June Calendar 6 Those participating in the conversations expressed a desire to be a well governed and healthy congregation attending to: 1 -the sharing of Christ's love with the world beyond Bethany's doors, both here in Onamia and far beyond. 2 -the spiritual wellbeing of the family of Bethany: -through Christ centered worship, with music that engages both the heart and the soul; -

The results of the Conversations are summarized below under the headings of "Currently Active Ministries" (ministries that the group wishes will continue) and "Potential Future Ministries". Priority points assigned by the ten people who generated the "Potential Future Ministries" list are shown in parenthesis as are the names of those interested in pursuing each area. Much additional help will be needed as Bethany engages in these ministries. So much so that the entire membership of Bethany and members of the Onamia community may find a place to be actively involved in God's mission in Onamia.

The Council will serve as an encourager of current, new and yet to be defined ministries. They will also, when requested and as able, provide resources and offer guidance to those taking leadership roles in the various ministries.

This report was submitted to the Bethany Lutheran Church Council for review and input. On August, 15, 2017 they approved this "Mission Plan" and intend to use it to guide the congregation's future efforts.
