² Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

We have been offering the Sacrament of Holy Communion on a weekly basis which helps us recapture the early (1st Century) Church's understanding of the meal (Holy Communion).

The followers of Jesus at the time of his death, the first Christians, were Jewish and regularly gathered on their Sabaoth, Saturday, for worship in the synagogue. They gathered for prayer, sang hymns, read scripture and listened to interpretation of scripture. A service very similar to what we do at Bethany on the Sundays we do not celebrate Holy Communion. In addition, every Sunday morning the followers of Jesus would gather for "the meal". They would share in the Body and Blood of their Savior, Jesus Christ. This sharing of the meal is what set them apart as Christians, as followers of Jesus. This practice continued until the Jewish authorities banned the followers of Jesus from the synagogue. When that happened, the Christians incorporated the Saturday service of word and prayer with their Sunday morning sharing of the meal. Over a couple thousand years this has evolved into our current practice of worship with Holy Communion.

Now, that we have experienced the "meal" and sharing in the Body and Blood of our Savior on a more regular basis, as the first century Christians did, how does it feel? How about we have some conversation about Communion practices.

May our journey through this time of Thanksgiving and on to the Christmas season bring us closer to Jesus and one another.

October 17, 2017 Bethany Church Council Meeting

Members present: N. Holen, P. Hook, V. Jones, R. Kephart, P. Olson, D. Peterson and Pastor John. Members absent: none

Devotions were given by Pastor John.

Consent Agenda was approved.

Old Business: A. Furnace Project Update- Ray reported that the furnace has been installed. The council also discussed having a basement clean up day. B. Basement flooring- The council discussed basement flooring options and decided to use the same tile and contractor, John's Flooring, to finish the hall-way, bathroom, and other rooms. A date hasn't been set yet for installation.

New Business: A. Lenten Services-The council discussed how can we improve attendance for the Lenten services. The council will invite Susan Bracken to the next meeting to be part of this discussion and planning process. B. Communication about Funerals- The council discussed how can we better inform Bethany members and the community about funerals that are scheduled. It was decided to post funeral information at the Post Office, Cedarwood, and the community bulletin board on Main Street in town. We decided to visit this item again in 6 months to see how this plan is working.

Project Updates: A. Thanksgiving Meal-Norma reported that we have received a \$500 donation from the Lions. Patti will be asking the academy students to help with serving and clean-up from 11:00-1:00. B. Alliance Youth- The Alliance Jr. High students will be using Bethany's basement on Wednesday evenings from 6:00-7:30. The meetings will start on Wed.Oct.25. Bethany will be providing some kind of treat and juice for our guests. The council will take care of the treats for the first several classes and then a sign up sheet will be available for people who would like to help provide snack. C. Urban Immersion- The council decided to use funds from the Bethany youth account to pay for anyone that would like to attend the Urban Immersion weekend in the Twin Cities in November.

Other: The next council meeting has been moved to Tuesday, November 14 at 7:00. There will be a Pastor review time allotted at the end of the regular meeting. The executive committee will meet with Pastor John to discuss information from the review and discuss his contract on Tuesday, November 28 at 7:00.


