### Un-approved Minutes for August 21, 2018 Council Meeting

Consent Agenda: The Consent Agenda was approved after the following item was discussed. Financial reports- Jennifer Crust, a CPA from the Brainerd area, agreed to look at our books for a significant discount since Bethany is a nonprofit organization. She was able to pinpoint some problem spots. The council approved to give J.Crust access to our computer remotely if necessary. Old Business: A. Parsonage shingles- The shingles on the parsonage need to be replaced. The council tabled this item until next spring. The parsonage now has an extra sump pump.

New Business: A. Meeting with Zion Lutheran Church- The council plans on meeting with Zion Lutheran Church in Milaca at 6:00 pm on August 22, 2018. B.
